**Paul G. Schervish, M.Div., Ph.D.**, is a retired Professor of Sociology and Director of the Center on Wealth and Philanthropy (CWP) at Boston College, served as a Fulbright Professor in Philanthropy at University College, Cork, Ireland, a distinguished visiting professor at the Indiana University Center on Philanthropy, a founding faculty member of the Legacy Companies Boston, and is the 2013 recipient of the Distinguished Career Award from the American Sociological Association's section on Altruism, Morality and Social Solidarity.

Paul is a prominent author, researcher and public speaker. He has been selected five times to the NonProfit Times annual "Power and Influence Top 50," a list which acknowledges the most effective leaders in the non-profit world.

Paul received his bachelor's degree in literature from the University of Detroit, a Masters in sociology from Northwestern University, a Masters of Divinity from the Jesuit School of Theology at Berkeley and his Ph.D. in Sociology from the University of Wisconsin, Madison.

Paul was a founding member of The Financial Awareness Foundation and now fondly remembered for his contributions as a TFAF Director Emeritus.
